

Pag-gamit Ng Bank transfer!

Tips on How to Make a Bank Transfer (*Furikomi*)

Send your remittances using your *Japanese Bank Cash Card* at any *Japanese Bank ATMs* and ATMs of some convenient stores like 7-11, Lawson, Family Mart, AM-PM etc.

Assistance can be asked from a Japanese Staff, just mention that you want to make a Bank Transfer (*Furikomi*) to this bank account:

Bank Name & Branch:	Mizuho Bank- Kamiyacho Branch
Account Name:	Philippine National Bank Tokyo Branch
Type of Account:	Ordinary (Futsu)
Account Number:	2467369

**Note: Once Bank Transfer (Furikomi) has been made; you must advise PNB for your remittance instruction. If it is not convenient for you to this all the time, apply for VIRTUAL ACCESS!*

Try Bank Transfer (*Furikomi*) at an ATM! Here are some *Kanji Characters* you might find useful.
